The Sculpture Center Broadens Call for Artists for Its Annual Juried Exhibition, On A Pedestal and Off The Wall

The Sculpture Center, Cleveland, Ohio, for the first time, has broadened its call for artists for its annual juried exhibition. **Artists of Ohio, its contiguous states (Michigan, Indiana, Kentucky, West Virginia, and Pennsylvania), and Ontario, Canada,** are invited now to submit entries for *On A Pedestal and Off The Wall*, on view from March 16 through April 14, 2007. This very popular exhibition of smaller sculptural works will be juried this year by the eminent Cleveland artist and educator Don Harvey. Past jurors have included the Chicago sculptor Richard Hunt and the renowned Cleveland designer and artist Viktor Schreckengost.

The call for artists for this juried sculpture exhibition is open through February 23. Entry guidelines, application form, and juror information are posted at www.sculpturecenter.org.

Ann Albano, newly appointed Executive Director of The Sculpture Center, explains, "By bringing together sculptors of this wider region, *On A Pedestal and Off The Wall* will highlight the extraordinary talent found beyond the major U.S. art centers. This yearly exhibition is an opportunity for dialogue among these sculptors, for greater exposure of their work, and for Clevelanders to see the diverse range of artistic talent and approaches to sculpture in this geographical region."

About The Sculpture Center

The Sculpture Center is located in Cleveland's University Circle neighborhood at 1834 East 123rd Street, off Euclid Avenue, beside Lake View Cemetery and two blocks from Little Italy. The Sculpture Center gallery is open Wednesday through Friday from 10 am to 4 pm, and Saturday from noon to 4 pm. The Sculpture Center offices are open weekdays from 10 am to 4 pm. Programs and hours are subject to change. Admission, parking, public receptions, and gallery talks are free. The Sculpture Center is handicapped accessible.

The Sculpture Center's mission is to place sculpture as an art form into the public discourse with the exhibition of artistic work by emerging Ohio sculptors and other sculptors of note, by the promotion of an appreciation and understanding of sculpture in its many forms through educational programming, and by the preservation of outdoor sculpture in Ohio.
