### MISSION

The Sculpture Center is dedicated to enhancing our community's appreciation of sculpture by fostering the careers of emerging sculptors and promoting the preservation of outdoor sculpture.

## Announcing the Window to Sculpture Schedule

The Sculpture Center has selected seven artists to exhibit in the 2003-2004 Window to Sculpture series. Window to Sculpture showcases emerging Ohio sculptors, each with a four-week gallery exhibit in which the artist is encouraged to show new work.

Gallery hours are Monday through Friday, 10 am to 4 pm, and Saturdays from noon to 4 pm. The exhibit, opening reception, and parking are free.

1) **Aug. 8 through Sept. 5, 2003: Bridget Lewis** features touchable mementos in porcelain with silkscreens and collage materials. Lewis encourages gallery visitors to handle the objects. Opening reception Friday Aug. 8, from 5 pm to 8 pm.

2) **Oct. 10 through Nov. 7, 2003: Eddie Fulcher** creates an installation of objects with similarities, including books, glass, furniture and neon. Opening reception Friday Oct. 10, from 5 pm to 8 pm.

3) **Nov. 21 through Dec. 19, 2003: Justin Coulter** constructs structural creations in bronze and steel that seem to defy gravity. Opening reception Friday Nov. 21, from 5 pm to 8 pm.

4) **Jan. 9 through Feb. 6, 2004: Greg Mueller** develops geometric and contemplative forms in forged steel, bronze, iron and wood. Opening reception Friday Jan. 9, from 5 pm to 8 pm.

5) **Feb. 13 through Mar. 12, 2004: Nick De Pirro** creates an installation of machine precision steel, bronze, iron and lead grouped with modifying objects. Opening reception Friday Feb. 13, from 5 pm to 8 pm.

6) **Mar. 19 through Apr. 16, 2004: Voss Finn** features contraptions made of vintage machine tool patterns and found objects. Opening reception Friday Mar. 19, from 5 pm to 8 pm.

7) **Jun. 11 through Jul. 9, 2004: Kim Eggleston Kraus** builds an interactive installation of walls and corridors with common building materials. Opening reception Friday Jun. 11, from 5 pm to 8 pm.

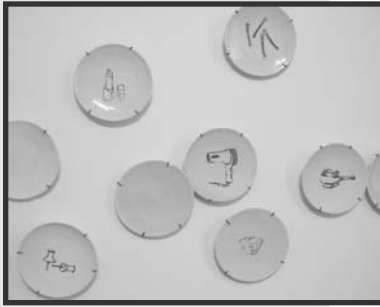

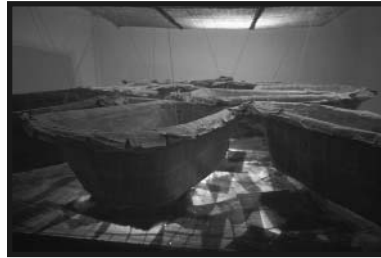
### Lend a Hand! Feed an Artist!

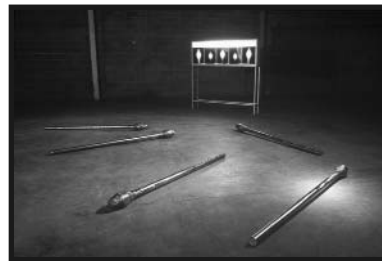

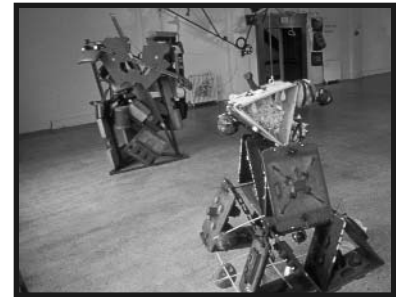
